



1- Open the Server Manager and click on Manage > Add Roles and Features.




2- Navigate to the Features section, selecting Windows Server Backup.




3- Click on Next, then Install.

Performing a System State Backup


- 1- Open Windows Server Backup from the Start Menu.

3- In the Actions menu, click Backup Once...




4- In the Backup Options, select Different options, then click Next.




- 5- Choose Custom backup configuration and click Next.

 - b. For network storage Select Backup to a shared folder, then provide the

network path.
